Dayvid: Mind-blowingly good. You never have time to even think about not being scared. Excellent set with a great flow from each area. Not only is it totally worth the wait in line or the price to get in, but you'll almost wish that you had paid more because you'll have gotten so much out of it.

Amy: Words can't even describe how awesome this haunt is. The actors give it 100% all the time, and they're *really* good. Field of Corpses is so good and so big, you could go through twice and it would scare you as much the second time as it did the first time. Absolutely mind-blowing, stomach-aching, right down an awesome haunted house. It makes you not feel safe because it's so scary!

Scott: Awesome haunt. I have never been so scared! It was awesome to watch the people in front of me and how they reacted to the props and actors, and I still got scared. It is really hard to believe that this is only the second year of the haunt with the way it came out.

Overall, I would have to say that if you only hit one this year, make sure it's this one!

Talia: This is an amazing haunted house. It's surprisingly scary for high-schoolers being the people who are scaring you. A good effect is the guide. The guides have everything to do with the scare because they keep you preoccupied. There is a lot of suspense, and you don't know what is going to come up next. It keeps you guessing. It's a great scare for the price.

Rob: Absolutely unreal. Field of Corpses is setting a new standard for haunted houses. The actors were excellent, and the attention to detail in sight and smell was astounding. My only deduction was a point in set design for too many props with the "latex look" and a failure to incorporate the element of sound. In the grand scheme of things, those are minor deductions for what is a truly phenomenal haunted experience.

This is quite possibly the best haunted house I have ever seen.

If you only go to one haunted house this year, don't miss Field of Corpses. It's an expertly crafted masterpiece of horror.

Erica: Phenomenal! Everything I look for in a haunt: atmosphere, believability, fright. I laughed, screamed, and nearly cried all the way through. This is one creepy haunt that won't disappoint!

Ky: Have you checked the scores? Need I really say more? I don't, but I will anyway.

First off, I like the idea of having a guide lead you through, but what makes it fun was how they interact with the group. I don't want to give anything away, but I have to say I see a definite step up from last year, and I thought last year was exciting.

It's not really easy to scare me because I just won't let myself be scared, but so many different things that I didn't expect kept happening, and when they happened, the effect was awesome.

As for the actors, I wish I could give them better than a 10. I was overly impressed by how many people there were and just how well they did. They were intimidating and in-your-face.

I struggled with the length. It ended a bit too abruptly, leaving me feeling like there should be more. I definitely wanted more! But, I must say, what was there looked great, was done with ultimate precision, and was just plain fun.

Victoria: Very well done. I can't emphasize enough how amazing the actors were; I couldn't ask for better. They engaged you throughout, especially the tour guides. They were awesome!

I really couldn't predict what was going to happen next. The set design was great, too. Nice touch at the beginning by playing old horror movie trailers while you wait in line. It was amazing overall, and I don't think I'd change anything if I could.
